

TULANE'S OWN WATER TANK DECORATED BY HATED RIVALS

Sting of Smarting Defeat Is Given Added Barb by the
Roistering Collegians of L. S. U., Who Daub With
Paint Place Reserve d for Local Victors.

L. S. U. adherents were not satisfied with their victory over Tulane Saturday. They had defeated their most hated rivals and had won against odds of six to five, three to two and a few two to one. They were drunk with prosperity and wanted to rub it in.

Saturday night they engaged a truck and proceeded to the neighborhood of Newcomb and Tulane to serenade the vanquished.

There was still some of the red paint left and while Tulanians were presumably slumbering the subtle up-statesmen climbed upon and decorated the

water tank with their symbolic Tiger and other reminders of their triumph.

The custom prevails at Tulane that each year the class winning the greatest number of inter-class athletic events is entitled to ornament the water tank with the modulus of their graduation year, and it certainly would not do to have L. S. U.'s handmark displayed there.

It is not good to work on Sunday, but in view of the extraordinary circumstances it was permissible, and loyal students were busy all day yesterday erasing the audacious work of their adversaries.
